

# **Daisy Petals Part 1:**

## **Lupe's Story:**

1. When did Lupe show that she was honest and fair?
2. How do you think the Flower Friends would have felt if Lupe had opened the present without them?
3. How do you think Lupe would feel if she had not shared the present?
4. When have you been honest and fair? How did it feel?

**Daisy To-Do:** Act the story out with your family to understand how Lupe was honest and fair while sharing the gift they received.

**Honest and Fair activity:** Play a game with your family at home (Duck, Duck, Goose/Red Light, Green Light/Musical Chairs). Talk about rules and then follow them as you play!

## **Sunny's Story:**

1. How did Sunny show that she was friendly and helpful?
2. How do you think Robin felt when Sunny offered to give Suzy a tour of the garden?
3. How do you think Suzy felt after Sunny gave her a tour of the garden and Buckley invited her to the party?

**Daisy To-Do:** Draw what happened in the story or draw a picture of what you imagine happened at Buckley's party.

**Friendly and Helpful activity:** Think of 3 ways that you can be helpful at home, then try to do at least one of those helpful things this week!

## **Zinni's Story:**

1. Why did Zinni forget to be considerate and caring at first?
2. What reminded her of her promise to act in a considerate and caring way?
3. How do you think the Flower Friends felt when they shared their coloring books, crayons, and markers instead of keeping them for themselves?

**Daisy To-Do:** Ask if you can help your parents set the dinner table or clean up after dinner sometime this week.

**Considerate and Caring activity:** Think of 3 ways you can be considerate and caring at home. Talk about it with your family and then draw a picture of you doing those things. Put the pictures up somewhere you can see to remind you to be considerate and caring everyday.
