• In recognition of the \$1 million dollar gift directed to the backyard of the Sally Cheever Girl Scout Leadership Center, the Fund Development Committee recommends Girl Scouts of Southwest Texas activate a \$5 million dollar major gifts campaign to realize the development of the backyard by December 31, 2024, with an annual review of progress to adjust as needed.
