The GSEMA Museum rents a variety of program kits that offer hands on learning and fun to enhance a troop meeting, service unit event or encampment. The rental fee for Program Kits is \$20. Browse through the program kit rental options and choose the one the works for you.

Active Citizenship Kit: Learn facts and put into practice responsibilities of United States citizenship. Learn about the symbols of our country, state and town. Learn and teach Patriotic songs. Discover the history of the American flag. Practice flag etiquette: fold, hang, display, and carry. Hunt for national, state and local landmarks. Kit contains flag, activities and ideas for learning and teaching others about active citizenship.

Adult Fashion Show: Enjoy a lighthearted look at what Girl Scouts used to wear – when and sometimes why – during the past (includes 16 uniforms, accessories and script).

Becoming Juliette: Bring our founder Juliette Gordon Low to life wearing a uniform and hat similar to what she wore as she spread the word about Girl Scouting. Perfect for book reports, historical presentations or school wax museum programs. Offered at a reduced fee of \$10 per kit.

Brownie Fashion Show/Play: Investigate the mystery of the old trunk with a fun fashion show for bridging Daisies or current Brownies in the form of a 10-minute play (includes 10 uniforms, 3 handbooks, and script).

Brownie Meeting from the Past: Go back in time with a troop program appropriate for Daisies and Brownies: What was it like to be a Brownie Girl Scout in the 1920s? Who were the "Brown Owls" and what was a "sixer"? What was "Twwhit, Towhoo"?

Ceremonies and Celebrations Kit: Learn how Girl Scouts mark special events and achievements with ceremonies and Girl Scout traditions throughout the year. Kit contains ideas and resources for: Flag ceremonies, Thinking Day, Court of Awards, Candle and Ribbon Ceremonies, World Association Pinning and more.

Flag Kit [US]: Learn how we honor our Country. Contains everything you need to put on the perfect flag ceremony. Kit includes: instructions for a flag ceremony, U.S. Flag, WAGGGS Flag, Council Flag, poles, belt holders, flag stands, 6 pairs of white gloves, 6 red sashes.

Forever Green: Celebrating 100 years of Girl Scouting: Connect to community service and help girls use their voices to let others know who we are. Designed for all Girl Scout levels, program is divided into three sections: Discover, Connect and Take Action to help inspire Girl Scouts to learn about Girl Scout History; celebrate being Girl Scouts; and think forward to the future of our Movement.
