spring is here!

Spring is a busy season in Girl Scouts, with so many fun things going on!

For starters, April is Volunteer Appreciation Month.

Though it's true we appreciate our volunteers and everything they do every single month of the year, April is the time of year that is specifically dedicated to expressing gratitude for all volunteers bring to the organization.

Throughout this month, take a moment to say thank you to the troop parents who have lent a helping hand, to the service team volunteers who work to support the troops in the area, and to each other. Celebrate what you can accomplish together and the great impact you have on the lives of the girls in your community.

Spring is also a time to celebrate the accomplishments of girls!

Troops and Service Units traditionally plan Court of Awards and Bridging Ceremonies in April and May. Be sure to reserve any ceremonial equipment as soon as possible to ensure it's available for your ceremony. It's also a good idea to purchase pins, badges, patches and thank you gifts from the Trefoil Trunk early on to make sure you have everything you need for your ceremony.

Remember, everyone is holding Court of Awards and Bridging Ceremonies at the same time and stock may be limited on some items. Planning ahead gives the Trefoil Trunks the ability to get everyone what they need in a timely manner. Check out <u>GSUSA's website</u> for more information on end of the year ceremonies.

Planning Summer Road Trips?

With spring here, you and your girls may be making plans for summer travel. Be sure to utilize the **Troop Travel and Readiness Guidelines** to assist in your planning. This resource will walk you through council and GSUSA travel guidelines, help the troop establish a travel budget, and gives you a space to collect all necessary information such as sleeping accommodations, emergency contacts, and driver information.

As you plan to travel, be sure to also review the <u>Trip/</u>
<u>Travel Safety Activity Checkpoints</u>, as well as any checkpoints for specific activities that may take place while on the trip.

Lastly, <u>Volunteer Essentials</u> has a great Travel Appendix that should be used as an additional resource when planning those fun summer trips.

For council staff, springtime means preparing for the upcoming Girl Scout year.

Throughout the season, staff will be contacting Troop Co-Leaders to collect information on the troop's future plans. Be prepared to let us know if your troop will experience a change in leadership, a new meeting location, or a new day and/or time of meetings in the 2019 membership year.

If your troop is not planning to continue, please review our Troop Disbanding Process and complete the steps necessary to properly close the troop.

Not sure if your girl will participate next year? Investing the First \$25 retains her membership and allows her to participate in all of the many Girl Scout opportunities during the 2018-2019 year including camp, events, and traveling.




At Girl Scouts, we care about your experience, good or bad, and we want to hear from you!

Last month Girl Scouts Heart of the South launched One Heart - our new underlying principle that encourages members to practice kindness and compassion, seek common ground and understanding, and serve our neighbors and communities, while living the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

Each month we will be featuring information for your troop to use during troop meetings to reinforce the One Heart principles.

For March we are launching One Heart Kindness Cards. These business size cards have a list of ideas for being kind on one side and a note to the recipient on the other asking them to continue to pay kindness forward. See the pictures below to see what the cards look like.

Each troop can order one set of 12 for the girls to use. Additional sets of 12 will be available in April and can be ordered for a \$5 donation to the council.

>>>Order your initial set of cards

Please take a few minutes at the troop meeting once you receive the cards and explain to the girls their use. Tell them they can take a card and choose one of the items on the back of the card to show kindness. They can also come up with their own idea and write it on the card.

Once they complete their act of kindness they need to leave the card so the person receiving their card can pass it forward to someone else. Give each girl a card and ask them to complete their random act of kindness before their next troop meeting.

Our world today is increasingly becoming an unkind world. It is important Girl Scouts show their communities the importance of being kind. These cards are a great way to help girls understand how to make a difference in the world. Girls that were not members by this date can apply and may be considered. All applications are confidential and cannot be considered until the \$50 camp registration fee is received. The deadline to apply is May 1. Apply now.
