



Girl Scouts Heart of the South West Tennessee Scholarship Application

(updated April 2023)

The purpose of the Girl Scouts Heart of the South West Tennessee Scholarship is to provide financial assistance through college scholarships to help facilitate the continuation of academic growth for Girl Scouts living in West Tennessee. Applicants must be graduating high school this year and have been accepted into a college or university. The scholarship is awarded based on achievement in Girl Scouting, academics, leadership, and extracurricular activities. Scholarship recipients can receive \$2,000 per year for four years.

DEADLINE for application is March 15.

The following five scholarships are available:

- E. Jane Hazlewood Leadership Scholarship
- Donna M. McHaffey Leadership Scholarship
- William R. Taylor Leadership Scholarship
- Susan C. Anderson Leadership Scholarship
- Sharon Younger Leadership Scholarship

To be eligible for a scholarship a girl must:

- Be a currently registered Girl Scout and preferably have been active throughout high school
- **Must be a Tennessee resident living in Benton, Carroll, Chester, Crockett, Decatur, Dyer, Gibson, Halls, Hardeman, Hardin, Haywood, Henderson, Henry, Lake, Lauderdale, Madison, McNairy, Obion, or Weakley county**
- Be a graduating High School Senior
- Have at least a 2.75 GPA
- Submit a copy of high school transcript
- Submit two letters of recommendation
- Submit a copy of a letter of acceptance to chosen college or university
- Meet the March 15 deadline for submitting the completed application
