Any contact with animals, Archery, Bounce Houses and related equipment, Campgrounds (other than GSCWM facilities), Chartered buses and other chartered vehicles (i.e. limousines, campers, boats), Challenge Courses and Ropes Courses, experience simulated skydiving and zero-gravity rooms, Gymnastics, Hayrides, Horseback Riding, Rafting and Boating, Climbing and Rappelling, Laser Tag, Parkour, Scuba Diving, Segway, Skating rinks (roller and ice), Ice Skating (at a rink), Skiing and Snow Tubing, Surfing, Swimming Facilities, Theme Parks, Vehicle Rental, Water Parks, Wind Surfing, Water Skiing and Wake Boarding, and Zip Lining.
