For this first report on the CBB Friends Endowment Fund, we would like to give some background and how the endowment fund for CBB grew since 2008. When our Girl Scout Councils merged in 2008, the fund was \$27,000. By 6/2019, CBB endowment fund grew to \$99,000 with added donations plus interest and minus upkeep expenses.

It was just after CBB's 100th anniversary that we embarked on our CBB Friends Endowment Campaign to raise \$250,000 and secure 100 Letters of Intent to make a legacy gift.
