

Rising Star Award

Description

This award is presented to a first or second year leader who has hit the ground running and made an immediate impact on Girl Scouts.

Criteria

- Nominee must be within the first two years of the role.
- The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout for a minimum of 12 months.
- The nominee has successfully completed a term of service and all requirements for the position.
- The nominee has performed beyond the expectations for the position to deliver the GSLE to girls using the National Program Portfolio.
- The nominee actively recognizes, understands and practices the values of inclusive behavior.

Nomination

A nomination form is completed and submitted to the council's recognition committee, along with supporting documentation indicating how the nominee meets the criteria. The recognition committee reviews the nomination documentation, then will approve or deny.

Examples of nominee

- A new Daisy leader has started a troop in the community. The
 volunteer has welcomed all interested girls into the troop with
 open arms. The troop has already earned all the petals, one
 journey, and has planted a community garden to donate
 produce to the local food pantry.
- A new volunteer decided to start a new Cadette troop to support an underserved community. With the volunteer's support the troop has grown into a large multi-level group that serves many girls at a local school. The group has created an anti-bullying program, as a result of the Amaze Journey for the entire school building.
