Spirit Award

Description

This award recognizes a volunteer who supports the Girl Scout Movement within the Girl Scouts of NYPENN Pathways. The recipient is known to work diligently behind the scenes, is first to provide extra assistance, and supports fellow Girl Scout volunteers and the troop.

Criteria

- The nominee must be a volunteer for a minimum of 2 years.
- The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout.
- The nominee has successfully completed a term of service and all requirements for the position.
- The nominee has performed beyond the expectations for the position to deliver the GSLE to girls using the National Program Portfolio.
- The nominee actively recognizes, understands and practices the values of inclusive behavior.

Nomination

A nomination form is completed and submitted to the council's recognition committee, along with supporting documentation indicating how the nominee meets the criteria. The recognition committee reviews the nomination documentation, then approves or denies.

Examples of nominee

- A volunteer of 5 years that consistently steps up and supports the troop leadership. He or she does all of the shopping, ordering, and prepares countless activities for the troop.
- A volunteer of 10 years that holds a position on the service unit team. He or she consistently mentors and supports new volunteers to ensure they have a strong and memorable first year in Girl Scouts.
