

Trefoil Award

Description

This award is recognizes a Girl Scout volunteer team within the Girl Scouts of NYPENN Pathways. This team works together to accomplish amazing goals that truly demonstrate the Go-Getter, Innovator, Risk Taker, and Leader capabilities in everyone.

Criteria

- All members of the team must be a volunteer for a minimum of 3 years.
- The team's efforts must have created a meaningful impact for one or more geographical areas (not just within one troop).
- The nominees are active, registered adult Girl Scouts.
- The nominees has successfully completed a term of service and all requirements for the position.
- The nominee has performed beyond the expectations for the position to deliver the GSLE to girls using the National Program Portfolio.
- The nominee actively recognizes, understands and practices the values of inclusive behavior.

Nomination

A nomination form is completed and submitted to the council's recognition committee, along with supporting documentation indicating how the nominee meets the criteria. The recognition committee reviews the nomination documentation, then approves or denies.

Examples of nominee

- A team of five volunteers continuously work together to facilitate a service unit wide events. The events are well attended and serves the needs of a community.
- A team of volunteers work together to create a day camp program. The day camp hosts 100 girls annually and provides a new experience to girls who would otherwise not have an outdoor experience.
