

Ever-Green Award

Description

This award recognizes a volunteer that has previously received the Appreciation Pin, Honor Pin, Thanks Badge, or Thanks Badge II. The volunteer has continued to provide amazing efforts for a minimum of three years after receiving the previous award.

Criteria

- The nominee must be a previous recipient of the Appreciation Pin, Honor Pin, Thanks Badge, or Thanks Badge II.
- The nominee must have continued service for three years since the previous award.
- The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout.
- The nominee has successfully completed a term of service and all requirements for the position.
- The nominee has performed beyond the expectations for the position to deliver the GSLE to girls using the National Program Portfolio.
- The nominee actively recognizes, understands and practices the values of inclusive behavior.

Nomination

A nomination form is completed and submitted to the council's recognition committee, along with supporting documentation indicating how the nominee meets the criteria. The recognition committee reviews the nomination documentation, then approves or denies.

Examples of nominee

 A Service Unit Manager has previously been awarded the Honor Pin for establishing an annual event for multiple counties. The leader has continued to expand on this event for the past three years and deserves to be recognized again.
