## Good Guy Award

### Description

This award recognizes a male volunteer who has given extraordinary or uncommon service in his community or in the council.

### Criteria

- Nominee must be a male volunteer.
- The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout.
- The nominee has successfully completed a term of service and all requirements for the position.
- The nominee has performed beyond the expectations for the position to deliver the GSLE to girls using the National Program Portfolio.
- The nominee actively recognizes, understands and practices the values of inclusive behavior.

### Nomination

A nomination form is completed and submitted to the council's recognition committee, along with supporting documentation indicating how the nominee meets the criteria. The recognition committee reviews the nomination documentation, then approves or denies.

### Examples of nominee

- A male troop leader plans and implements a new STEM focused series for interested girls. This series is open to all Girl Scouts throughout NYPENN Pathways.
- A male volunteer wants to support the service unit and make a lasting impact for future Girl Scouts. He takes his personal time and money to build a beautiful bridge for bridging ceremonies.
