GIRL SCOUT LEADERSHIP EXPERIENCE PROGRAM COMMITTEE

Purpose:

The committee will ensure that the Girl Scout Leadership Experience is available to all girls within the region and is relevant to the girls' needs and interests. The committee is responsible for coordinating community and regional program events, activities and trips. The GSLE Program Committee will oversee and support community volunteers and volunteer teams who will plan and implement community level events, activities or trips that are relevant to the girls' interests and needs. The committee communicates with the program department to ensure consistency in the delivery of program events, activities, etc.

Accountability: Committee Chair

Key Tasks:

- Responsible for ensuring that events are established and offered in all areas of region
- Attends community meeting to recruit and mentor volunteers to plan and implement events on community/regional level
- Maintains community/regional calendar of events
- Reviews and approves "Intent to Event" proposals
- Works with the Product Sale Committee to support the program aspect of product sales, including facilitating rallies on community/regional level
- Identifies potential indoor and outdoor event sites and locations
- Supports and Promotes council activities
- Works with the Program Staff to coordinate level and regional encampments
- Promotes service project opportunities/environmental issues and shares with the GSLE Committee and the Program Department
- Requests support from the Program Departments as needed
- Ensures there is recognition of important Girl Scout celebrations such as Thinking Day, Girl Scout Birthday and Juliette Gordon Lows Birthday
- Promotes events through various media outlets
