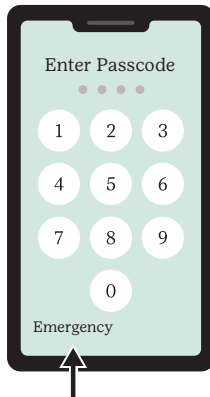




Dialing 911

Supports Meeting 1, Activity 2, Choices 1, 2, and 3

Practice dialing 911 so you'll know how to call for help in an emergency.



Most cell phones are locked. This means you need a password or passcode to use them. The lock screen will have the word “Emergency” on it. Touch “Emergency” to call 911.

If the phone is unlocked, use the keypad.

Touch 9, then 1, then 1. Press the picture of the phone handset at the bottom of the screen to make the call.

Use this phone to practice dialing 911.

Remember:
ONLY call 911 in an emergency!

Note: There are lots of different phones. Their screens may not look exactly like those on this page. But they should all have similar features.
