

Cybersecurity Basics 2 Name That Hacker! Cards

A hacker launches an attack to steal users' credit card numbers.	A hacker discovers a security vulnerability in a program and discloses it to the developer, so that it can be fixed immediately.
A hacker finds a security vulnerability in a program and sells it to an organization on the black market.	A hacker is employed to test an organization's computer security systems and reports back with information about how to make them more secure.
A hacker discovers a security vulnerability in a program and discloses that information publicly.	A hacker dislikes a particular website and creates a botnet that floods that website with so much traffic that it shuts down.
A hacker compromises a computer system without permission but tells the organization after the fact so they can fix the problem.
