MEETING 2 ACTIVITY CHOICES

Follow the Parade

Join a Parade: Gather Brownie friends, or other Girl Scouts, and join a parade. Before you go, find out why the parade is happening, and make a banner to carry that will help share the reason with others.

Learn to March: Ask an experienced marcher, like someone in the military or in a marching band, to show you how to march. Practice different marching steps and signals for starting and stopping. Then try to march for an entire marching song!

See a Band Review or Field Show: Some schools or community groups compete in parades or fields shows, playing music and doing complicated steps. Find an event and take a field trip with an adult and your Brownie friends.

Join a Ceremony or Celebration

Join a Flag Ceremony: Ask an older Girl Scout or another expert to show you how to fold an American flag and how to be a flag bearer. Then take part in a flag ceremony!

Join a Town Ceremony: There are ceremonies to celebrate town events like anniversaries or the birthday of an important person. Sports games often begin with a ceremony. Find one and join in!

Make Up Your Own!: Make a banner with a symbol, choose music, and create a ceremony for something you think is special. Invite your family and friends to join in.
