MEETING 2 ACTIVITY CHOICES

Build a Safe Campfire

Learn How to Build a Fire & Learn How to Safely Put Out a Fire: Have an adult help you build and light a fire that is safe, then work with them to put it out safely.

Take Care of Wildlife

Be the Best Guest: Imagine your favorite wild animal and think of ways that humans can be disrespectful of its living space. Draw or paint a picture of your animal and talk about how humans can treat its living space kindly when they are outside.

Keep Animal Homes Safe: With the help of an adult, find out what kinds of homes are built by wildlife in your area and go exploring to see if you can find some of these homes outdoors. Draw a picture or make up a story about who lives there, why they chose that place, and how people can make sure the home is a safe and peaceful place to live.

Visit a Wildlife Rescue Agency: Visit a wildlife rescue agency and talk to a wildlife rehabilitator about the work they do. Do they know about the Leave No Trace guidelines? How do they follow them in their work?
