Activity Choice Descriptions

Walk your girls through the activity choices and let them decide which ones they like best.

Meeting 2 Activity Choices

Find Your Voice:

Repeat a Word, Sentence, and Passage: Pick a tricky word and say that word four times using different emotions. Then you'll try it with movie quotes and Shakespeare passages.

Tell Your Story: Write a short life story, then perform that story as if it was a drama and a comedy.

Practice Impressions: Choose a famous person and study them in clips of performances or interviews. Then do an impression for the group and see if they can guess who you are.

Choose or Create a Piece to Perform:

Write a Speech About Something You Believe in: Write a speech about a cause or issue that's important to you, then practice before performing it for the group in the next activity.

Create a Piece: Write a monologue for a character you'd like to play, then practice before performing it for the larger group in the next activity.

Pick an Existing Piece: Choose a monologue that you relate to from a play or show, then practice before performing it for the larger group in the next activity.

Get Onstage:

Create a Theater: Create a theater (in someone's home or your meeting space) to perform your speeches for other Girl Scouts, friends, or family.

Perform at School: Perform your speeches at school—it could be for your class, a class of younger kids, or the whole student body.

Go to Your Audience: Perform your speeches in front of a group in your community.
