

Coins

Below are the coins used in the United States. Each coin has a different value.

A penny = 1 cent.

The 16th president, Abraham Lincoln, is on the front of the penny. On the back is a Union Shield with words that mean "out of many, one."



A nickel = 5 cents.

The 3rd president, Thomas
Jefferson, is on the front
of the nickel. On the back
is Monticello, which was
Jefferson's home in Virginia.



A dime = 10 cents.

The 32nd president, Franklin D. Roosevelt, is on the front of the dime. On the back is the torch of liberty, an olive branch for peace, and an oak branch for strength and independence.



A quarter = 25 cents.

The 1st president, George
Washington, is on the front of
the quarter. The back design
changes often. It's been an eagle,
national parks, and a drummer.
