



How To Make a Nectar Feeder

What you'll need:

- A clean, empty spice jar or jar with lid
- Scissors
- String
- Red paint and/or red foam
- Hot glue (for an adult to help you)
- Nectar

How to make it:

1. Make holes in the lid of your jar.
2. Paint your jar or cut out shapes to make red foam flowers that you can attach to your jar.
3. Measure, cut, and attach string around the lip of the jar for it to hang.
4. Fill the jar with nectar.
5. Hang the jar by the string on a tree branch, porch, or other outdoor place.

How To Make Nectar:

What you'll need:

- 1 cup water
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup extra-fine or superfine white granulated sugar
- Mixing bowl
- Whisk or mixing spoon
- Funnel

How to make it:

Mix $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of sugar in 1 cup of water until the sugar dissolves. Use the funnel to pour your nectar into the feeder. You can keep extra nectar in the fridge for 7–10 days.
