MEETING 2 ACTIVITY CHOICES

Find Music in Nature

Sing Outdoors: Learn a new song with Girl Scout friends and sing it in a round. Then, go on a walk with some friends and try playing follow the leader: Change the speed of the song to match the leader's walking pace.

Make Rainy Day Music: Do you know the sounds of a rainstorm? How do the sounds change as the rain gets heavier and lighter? Try to recreate the sounds of a rainstorm with music.

Create "Nature's Symphony": Make music with items you find in nature.

Be a Nature Photographer

Play with Light: Find an outdoor space that you love and photograph it at three different angles.

Explore Structures: Head outdoors to explore buildings and other structures in your area. Take a picture of one structure that you think works with nature, and one that doesn't. Get together with your Girl Scout friends to compare and discuss your photos.

Go Big and Small: Take a series of photos where you get closer to an object until it's difficult to tell what it is. Share your photos with family and friends—see how long it takes them to guess what's shown in the pictures.

Design with Nature

Design Outdoor Art: Sketch or paint a picture of the kind of outdoor art you'd like to see in your community.

Design a Bird, Bat, or Owl House: Design a bird, bat, or owl house that will be a welcome shelter and also add to the beauty of nature.

Design a Terrarium: Sketch or paint a design for a terrarium that reminds you of your favorite outdoor space.
