## **Is it Phishy?**

	<ul> <li>□ Are there spelling mistakes? Fake emails often have misspellings in them.</li> <li>□ Is the person in the email offering something that's too good to be true? Scammers will often say you can get free electronics or other expensive items by clicking on something. They might say: "Act now, it's free!"</li> <li>□ Is the email making an offer for something? Does it look like an advertisement? It's spam.</li> <li>□ Is the email asking for your private information? Never share private information through an email.</li> <li>□ Is the email marked "urgent" or threatening something? Scammers often say things like: "You need to act on this offer now! Urgent!"</li> <li>□ Does the message have an attachment? Never click on an attachment in an email unless you know the person who sent it.</li> </ul>
