PROJECT PREPARATION TIPS

Combine the girls' skills and yours with the support of your Network to give the Brownies a powerful learning experience—and a project that has an impact.

Ask around.

Share with your Network what the girls have planned thus far. Reach out into the Girl Scout community. Other adult volunteers may have connections related to the project or its possible location.

Organize the effort.

What will the girls do? What will the Network do? Who among the Network can assist with what? When and where will the project take place? Do you need to chat with school administrators or other officials?

Go bigger, go smaller.

The main thing is to keep the excitement and enthusiasm going. If the girls want to do more and have the time—fantastic! If the project has hiccups or too many obstacles, scale it back. Remind the girls that big is not always best.

Roll with it.

The project may not take shape as you and the girls have envisioned it. So be flexible!

Remember the benefits.

This project lets girls strengthen their leadership skills, and their confidence.
