Sample Community Data Set & Pie Chart

Gathering data about a community's perceptions and sentiments can be a good way to understand what is important to that community. Different people have different ideas, even if they are members of a community. Surveys collect data to get a picture of a group based on individual responses.

Below is a sample data set and pie chart based on the issue of protecting the environment. You can find the blank template under the Meeting Aid "Community Survey Pie Chart Template".

Issue: The Environment

Question: How much do we need to change our behaviour to protect the environment?


Data Collection:

Pie Chart:

Pie chart for a group of 10 girls on importance of protecting the environment:



Interpretation:

The bar chart might show the importance of the issue. If people don't want to fundamentally change their behaviour the chart might be more shaped like a 'bell curve'. A relatively flat line could show that there's no consensus about what needs to happen. A sloping line would indicate more consistent thoughts about the issue.
