| <p>Codeword: RENEGADE</p> <p>Used by: the Secret Service Meaning: President Obama</p> | <p>Codeword: CODE OSCAR</p> <p>Used by: sailors Meaning: Man overboard</p> |
| <p>Codeword: DOCTOR FIRESTONE</p> <p>Used by: Medical personnel Meaning: Fire Sample Usage: <i>"Paging Dr. Firestone to the fifth floor" means there is a possible fire on the fifth floor.</i></p> | <p>Codeword: CODE ADAM</p> <p>Used by: all federal buildings; many department stores, hospitals, etc. Meaning: There is a missing child</p> |
| <p>Codeword: CODE 10</p> <p>Used by: Walmart Meaning: There has been a spill of dry goods</p> | <p>Codeword: CODE BLUE</p> <p>Used by: Medical personnel Meaning: A patient is in cardiac arrest</p> |
| <p>Codeword: 10-1</p> <p>Used by: Radio operators Meaning: Bad reception</p> | <p>Codeword: NORA</p> <p>Used by: public places, like malls and convention centers Meaning: "Need officer right away" (used to call law enforcement without anyone noticing)</p> |

| <p>Codeword: PAN-PAN</p> <p>Used by: pilots, ship captains Meaning: state of urgency on a ship or aircraft (i.e. engine problems) Sample usage: <i>“Pan-Pan, Pan-Pan, Pan-Pan,” then the location of the vehicle, the type of problem and assistance needed</i></p> | <p>Codeword: CODE 3</p> <p>Used by: emergency responders (police, firefighters, EMTs) Meaning: Drive with lights and sirens on</p> |
| <p>Codeword: CODE 10</p> <p>Used by: store cashiers Meaning: Suspicious credit card that needs to be verified by the credit card company</p> | <p>Codeword: 7500</p> <p>Used by: pilots Meaning: The plane has been hijacked</p> |
| <p>Codeword: ECHO, ECHO, ECHO</p> <p>Used by: ship captains Meaning: two ships are about to collide</p> | <p>Codeword: 10-50</p> <p>Used by: police officers Meaning: auto accident, property damage only, no injuries reported</p> |
| <p>Codeword: CODE BRAVO</p> <p>Used by: airport employees Meaning: a major security breach or bomb threat at the airport</p> | |
