Put a heart next to any devices that you would like to have in your home someday.	
	Coffee table: Contains a screen on the tabletop, which you can use to browse the internet
	Television: Browse the internet and watch online videos or movies from various subscription services
	Refrigerator: You can adjust the temperatures on various compartments so that they can become refrigerators or freezers with the touch of a button. The smart fridge will also display your family's calendar, shopping list, reminders, and/or family photos.
	Thermostat : Adjust the temperature of your house remotely, and set up customized temperature settings for when you're at home and away
	Curtains: Automate your curtains so that they open and close at pre-set times
	Door locks and doorbells: Open your doors with a code or a touch screen instead of a key! You can also install a video doorbells so that you can safely see who is at the door.
	Faucets : Preset the temperature of your shower, or start running your bathwater while you're still in the kitchen.
	Security system : Security alarms and cameras can be controlled remotely, so that you can always see what's happening in your home when you are away
	Lights: Control the brightness and colors of the lights throughout your home
	Voice assistant: A voice-controlled device that you can use to play music in your home, set up reminders, ask questions, and/or order products
	Robot vacuum and/or mop: Connects to your phone or virtual assistant to ensure your floors stay clean
	Coffee maker: Allows you to brew the perfect cup of coffee before you've even gotten out of bed yet and sends notifications when you need to buy more coffee beans
	Self-cleaning litter box: Save yourself trouble by programming the litter box to clean itself however often you need!
	Dash buttons: Small WiFi-connected devices that reorder your favorite products (e.g. detergent) with the push of a button
