Slope Awareness

Learn the etiquette (yes, manners!) of skiing/snowboarding and how to be aware on the slopes.

- Follow right of way: People ahead of you always have the right of way, so watch for them.
- Make others aware before you turn. Do not cross the path of skiers or snowboarders.
- Stay in control. Always be able to avoid people, trees, or objects.
- Prepare for falls. Move quickly to the side of the trail or slope after falling, unless you are injured.
- Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- Know how to ride a lift. You should be able to load, ride, and unload safely.
- Look for the ski patrol if someone is injured. Ski patrol members are usually dressed in red.
- Know the slopes. Go over the area's trail maps before hitting the slopes.
