### **Some Safe Toys**

#### **Infants (Newborn to 6 Months)**

- · Soft blocks
- Simple rattles
- · Stuffed animals

#### Infants (7 to 12 Months)

- · Large colored blocks made of rubber or soft material
- · Large stacking boxes or rings
- · Squeaky toys or bells
- · Large balls
- · Simple picture books or cloth books
- Push toys without rods
- Teethers

#### **Toddlers (1- and 2-Year-Olds)**

- Building blocks
- Large rubber toy people/animals
- Large crayons, markers, nontoxic finger paints and paper
- · Simple puzzles with knobs
- Small hand puppets
- Ride-on transportation toys
- Cymbals, drums, xylophones, and other musical instruments

#### **Preschoolers (3- and 4-Year-Olds)**

- Simple board games
- Storybooks
- Balls
- Musical instruments
- Realistic dolls, stuffed animals, and sock or mitten puppets
- Tricycles and wagons
- Puzzles with large pieces

# Younger School-Age Children (5-, 6- and 7-Year-Olds)

- Board games and puzzles
- Kits related to hobbies like science, arts, crafts and music
- Electronic games
- · Dolls and action figures
- · Bikes and scooters

## Older School-Age Children (8-, 9- and 10-Year-Olds)

- Sports equipment
- Bikes
- · Remote control cars
- · Construction sets
