



Girl Scout Bronze and Silver Award Money Earning Overview

- » For tax reasons and to support our 501 (c)(3) designation, all fundraising must be processed and acknowledged by the council Finance and Fund Development teams
- » Girl Scouts earning their Bronze and Silver Awards MAY NOT directly ask for monetary donations, only in-kind donations. An in-kind donation is a contribution of goods or services, other than cash.
- » Girl Scouts looking to solicit in-kind donations must fill out the following form for approval: <https://bit.ly/in-kind-request>
