The board will be used to showcase your work in an easy-to-view way and can help to spread the word about your project. You are encouraged to use pictures and other visual aids to make your board stand out. Your information should be a brief, but clear.

Your Display Board may be designed in any way you'd like but must include the following information. Your answers should be a brief, but informative and can be shown in whatever way best suits your project.

» Project Information

- Project title
- Your name
- Year award was earned
- Project Advisors name
- Total number of hours spent

» Issue Addressed

- What was it you wanted to fix and why?
- What was the root-cause of your issue?

» Project Goal

- What was the goal of your project and how did you measure it?

» Project Steps

- What steps did you take to complete your project?

» Sustainability

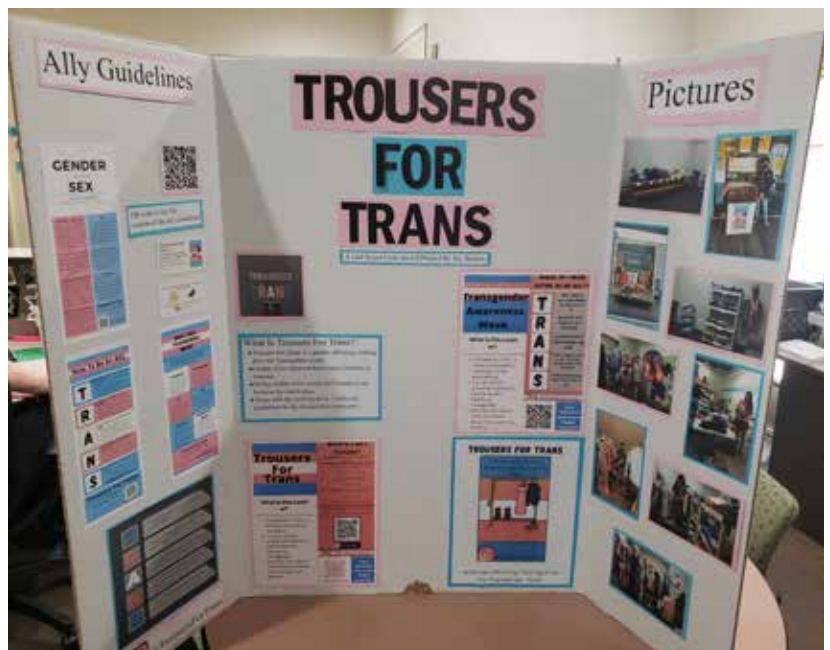
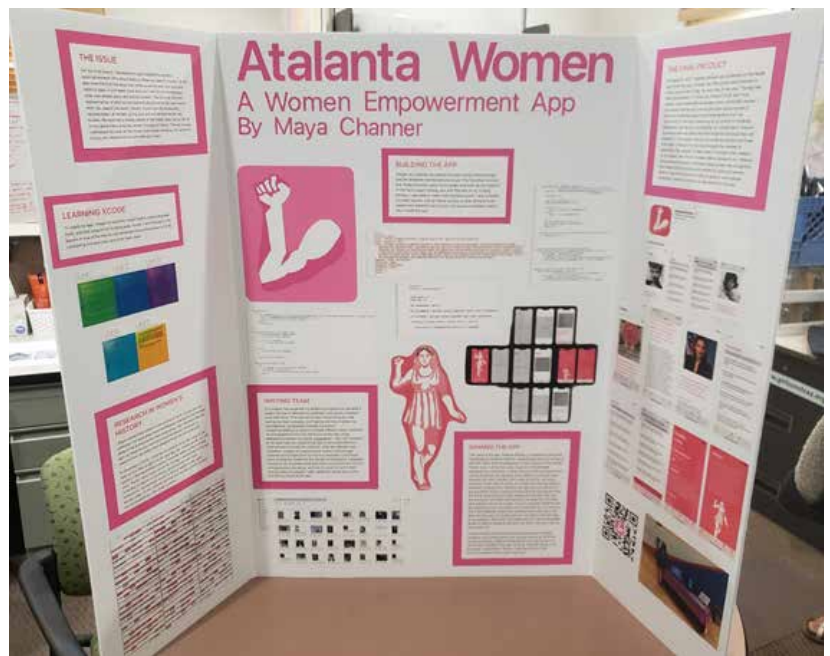
- How will your project or the impact that it made continue now that you are done?
