Each beautiful property is home to various activities that will help girls, regardless of their experience with Girl Scouts, break out of their comfort zone. Whether it is hiking, ceramics, mountain biking, or enhancing their teamworking skills, girls will leave each session feeling confident and empowered. Resident Camp – Are you comfortable spending long periods of time away from home and want to grow your outdoor adventure skills? Then this is the camp for you! Residential camps are 6 days and 5 nights: sessions include Counselor in Training 1 & 2 and out-of-camp experiences.

How to Register

1 Choose the camp session(s) you'd like to attend.

2 Choose additional purchase options.

- Transportation
- Pre-ordered items
- Trading Post (camp shop) account

3 Pay a non-refundable deposit to reserve your spot.

All deposits go towards the total cost of camp, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and must be made using a credit card.

- 10% deposit per camper for each 3-day+ session
- \$10 deposit per person for Family and Troop Camps

4 Decide how to make payments.

- Pay by credit card online or by phone with the GSACPC Customer Care team.
- Apply Program Credits and/or Camp Vouchers to camp sessions or bus transportation. Review guidelines before redeeming credits at girlscoutsaz.org/program-credits.
