	Lodge	50 overnight – winter months	12 table/bench units, large outdoor patio with built-in grill, stone fireplace, commercial kitchen, five flush toilets, five sinks, 50 mattresses during winter season only, no shower facilities. PLEASE DON'T BRING STAINING DRINKS INTO THE LODGE (KOOL-AID, GRAPE JUICE, ETC.)
	Cook's Cabin	6 overnight – year round	2 rooms, 1 bathroom, small covered porch, 3 bunk beds
	Staff House	18 overnight – year round	Large living area, 2 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, residential kitchen, covered porch, handicap accessible, 12 floor mattresses, 3 bunk beds
	Solar Cabin	14 overnight – year round	Large covered porch, 2 sleeping areas, composting toilet, residential kitchen, fire ring, 14 floor mattresses
	Jean Clark Infirmary / Wellness Center	18 overnight – year round	3 rooms, 2 bathrooms, residential kitchen, handicap accessible, fire ring, 11 floor mattresses, 3 bunk beds one double/full bed
	Big Cabin formerly Nature Center	18 overnight – year round	2 small rooms, 1 bathroom, residential kitchen, fire ring, 6 bunk beds, 6 floor mattresses
	Director's Cabin	6 overnight – year round	Deck, large 1 bedroom, 1 bathroom, 6 floor mattresses, fire ring
Wi	Wrangler Cabins	11 overnight – year round	1 cabin with 5 beds and 1 cabin with 6 beds, shower house (summer only), electricity, lights and heat. <i>If horses are scheduled, one cabin will become unavailable to utilize for horse staff.</i>
	Greenwood Units	30 overnight – year round	6 cabins, shower house, ramada, picnic tables, water, pole light, fire ring, 5 beds in each cabin, electricity, lights and heat
	Frontier Units Pine Tree Units Creekside Units	30 overnight – summer only	6 cabins in each unit, shower house w/ea unit, ramada, picnic tables, water, pole light, fire ring, 5 beds in each cabin – only 1 cabin in each unit has electricity and a light.
	Hilltop Units	40 overnight – year round	7 cabins, shower house, ramada, picnic tables, water, pole light, fire ring, 5 beds in each cabin with exception of 1 cabin has 10 beds, electricity, lights and heat.

		Greenwood Ramada	30 day use – year round	Covered area, 4 picnic tables, electric and lights, trash cans. Water hydrant in area.
		Frontier Ramada Pinetree Ramada Creekside Ramada	30 day use – year round	Covered area, 4 picnic tables, electric and lights, trash cans. Water hydrant in area.
		Hilltop Ramada	40 day use – year round	Covered area, 4 picnic tables, electric and lights, trash cans. Water hydrant in area.
		Main Fire Ring	120 day use – year round	Large area, fire ring, water, electric
		Archery Area	As scheduled – year round	Shed, targets, ramada. Council approved training is required to use this facility with an instructor. Restricted to girls 9 and older and Junior and above.
