

Summary/Objective:

The role of the security volunteer will be to recognize situations and respond as needed to problems related to safety, site security, and assist with general questions. The main objective for this role is to keep girls, chaperones, volunteers, and staff safe.

Reports to: Volunteer Leader

Essential Functions:

- Periodically patrol grounds
- Enforce site and safety rules
- Alert staff of any concerns or reoccurring issues
- Assist in any emergency management (Evacuations, escort EMS or emergency medical staff to scene, situational emergency crowd control)
- Assist with regulating vehicle and pedestrian traffic as needed

Required Certification, Qualification, and Experience:

- For the roles required to drive a golf cart or transport vehicle:
 - Valid driver's license
 - Clean driving record

Physical Demands:

- Standing for long periods of time
- Navigating uneven terrain

Time Commitment:

- Jamboree responsibilities will start from 3:00pm Friday and run through 12:00pm Sunday. You are not required to be on duty the entire time, but all support will be greatly appreciated.
 - Day shift:
 - Friday: 2:00pm-6:00pm, 6:00pm-10:00pm
 - Saturday: 6:00am-10:00am, 10:00am-2:00pm, 2:00pm-6:00pm, 6:00pm-10:00pm
 - Sunday: 6:00am-10:00am
 - Night Shift: on call as needed
 - Friday: 10:00pm-6:00am
 - Saturday: 10:00pm-6:00am
